

HEAD LICE

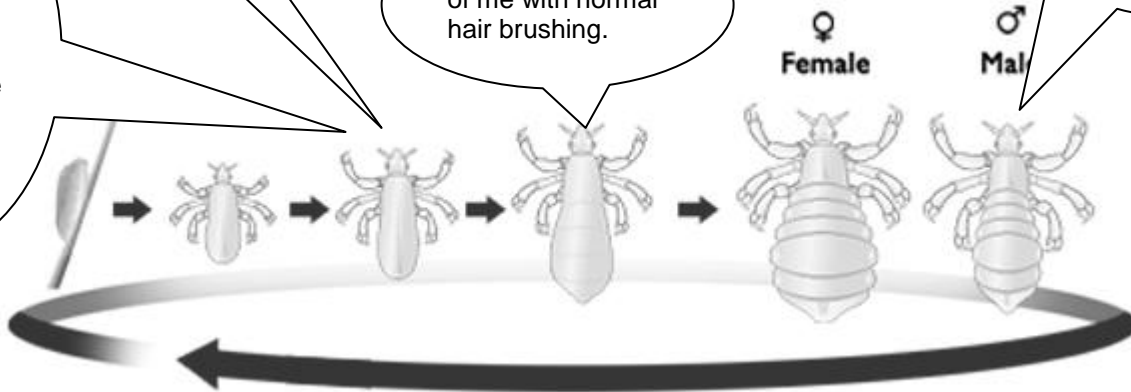
The facts and the falses!
